## PARKING

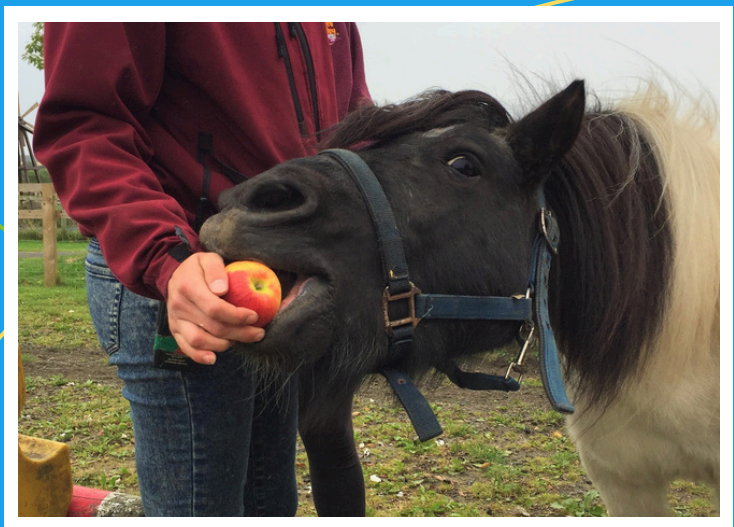

# Things to know, BEFORE your visit...

We **ADVISE** you to do a pre-visit to our farm, during which you can carry out your own Risk Assessment, become familiar with the site and help plan the visit itinerary. Ensure everyone wears appropriate outdoor clothing, including sturdy shoes for their visit. For the summertime, we recommend sun hats and regular SPF application.

Please make us aware of any allergies prior to your visit that we must know of, so our team can appropriately control and accommodate for this.



# HEALTH & SAFETY



Our animal care is at the highest level and priority is always given to our protection of disease through control measures certified by KIWA. Some animal diseases can be transmitted to humans.

There is a small risk of children acquiring infections such as: Cryptosporidium, Campylobacter, Ecoli 0157 and Salmonella; These organisms can be contracted by hand to mouth contact.

## Health & safety Guidelines

- Wash you hands using soap & running water before eating or drinking, after touching the animals.
- \*disinfectant gel DOES NOT replace the washing of hands.
- Do not allow the children to kiss animals.
- Children should not put fingers in their mouths, unless hands are washed after touching animals.
- Eat only in the designated eating areas located in cafe, conservatory or outdoor picnic spaces.
- Do not allow the children to climb on any walls, fences or gates.
- Any cuts, wounds & grazes must be covered with a waterproof dressing to avoid infection.
- Children's dummies that have fallen to the ground should not be put back into children's mouths.
- Wear suitable clothing and footwear, take into account the weather (Winter/Summer).
- Children must stay with their group at all times.
- Ensure all responsible adults are aware of the rules, the group remains your responsibility.
- Smoking, is NOT permitted on site.
